# **User manual**

#### DELTA TRAP

Delta traps are highly effective for monitoring harmful moths. The male moth is attracted into the trap by a synthetic pheromone contained in a lure and gets caught on the sticky insert.

## Composition of the delta trap


Each delta trap contains the following components:

- 1 delta trap with Biobest logo (1)
- 4 sticky inserts (2)
- 1 pheromone holder + basket (3)
- 1 string to suspend the trap (4)


**Attention!** This delta trap contains no pheromone lures. These must be ordered separately.



## How to assemble the delta trap?



Fold the trap like a triangle.



Fold the flap (A) upwards and slide the ends of this flap through the slits, so that the flap stays upright.

At the other side of the trap, you slide the sticky insert (B) inside and thereafter you fold the flap upwards, with the ends through the slits.



Click the green basket in the pheromone holder and fix the holder on the roof of the trap.

Slide the ends of the string through the small holes on top of the trap and the trap is ready for use.

Place the pheromone lure in the basket or on the sticky insert.

#### Dosage and position

For greenhouse crops, the traps should be suspended (2 traps per ha) just above the crop. In orchards, the traps should be suspended at eye level. The sticky insert should be inspected at two-day intervals. Replace the lures every 4-6 weeks and the sticky inserts when fully covered with insects.
